A few days ago I received a request from a Hindawi publication (Mathematical Problems in Engineering) to referee a paper which I declined. I just realized that the paper I promised to review for EJOR is the same paper the same author submitted to Hindawi. Please see below the email I received from the Hindawi editor.

As you know, submitting the same paper to more than one journal simultaneously is unethical and cannot be tolerated. In such cases, the editors normally reject the paper immediately and place the author(s) in a black list.
